VIBURNUMS ARE EXPLODING THIS YEAR- Sandy Orr



If your viburnums survived the long deep freeze, they burst into flower this year. My four different types mimicked those of my neighbors in an extraordinary show. I grow a Japanese snowball or viburnum macrocephalum, a doublefile 'Shasta', an evergreen dwarf Laurustinus foundation planting, and a dwarf evergreen obovatum foundation planting. It took me a long time with much trial and error to find the dwarf foundation plantings that actually stayed dwarf and didn't shoot up to 12 foot shrubs. All is well now, and I can see out my windows again.
