Eleven Master Gardeners were met at 9:00am with a cool 42 degree temperature and cloudy, damp conditions. But the weather didn't stop them from having a wonderful morning full of laughs and fun. For two and a half hours they moved two Junipers and planted 31 pansies. Next they planted some Dwarf Gardenias, Miscanthus Sinenis Grass, Pink Muhly Grass and two Dwarf Holly bushes. They finished the project off with a layer of pine straw mulch for just the right look. The Lakelands Master Gardeners continue to serve the Lakelands area year round with horticultural help and education.
